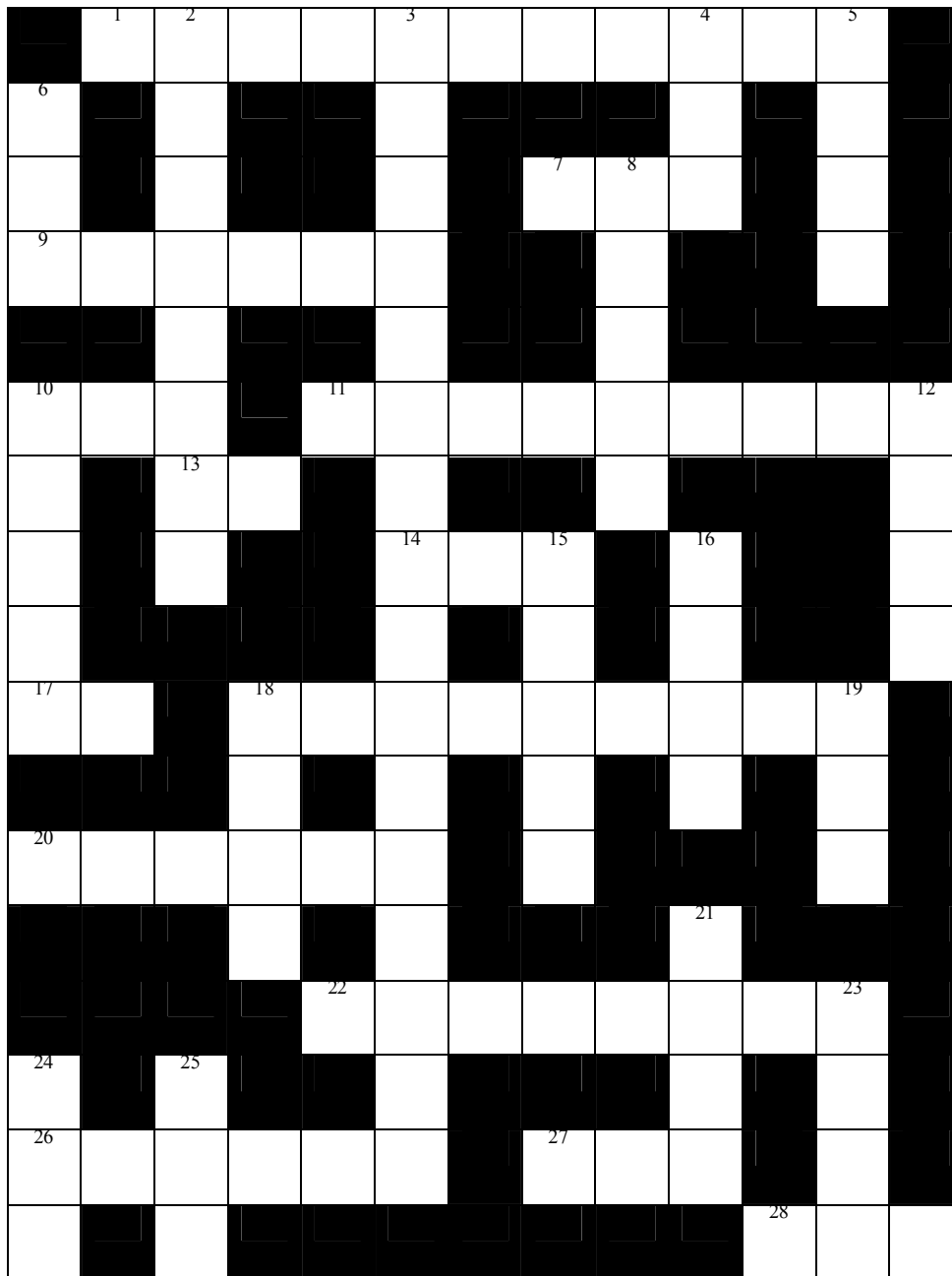


ANATOMY CROSSWORD # 3
