

## 4<sup>th</sup> MCI Fellowship in Medical Education ( FIME )

28<sup>th</sup> March 2016 to 1<sup>st</sup> April 2016

The Medical Council of India has started an advance faculty development course, termed as Fellowship in Medical Education (FIME) at 10 Nodal centers across the country. Your college has been allocated to GSMC-KEMH-MCI Nodal center. It may be pointed out that Medical Council of India has prescribed following minimum qualification for a teacher to be considered as a faculty in basic education workshops (any one of these):

1. Degree in medical education
2. Diploma in medical education
3. FAIMER (Foundation for Advancement of International Medical Education and Research) Fellowship
4. Advanced course in medical education (project based longitudinal course)

In case the faculty of your college conducting basic education course do not have any one of these, then they will not be counted as faculty for basic course. Hence, **it is necessary that your faculty conducting Basic Courses should enroll for Fellowship in Medical Education.** We request you to nominate faculty from your college for the said course, the details of which are as follows:

The FIME is offered as two contact sessions at Seth G S Medical College, Mumbai during October and March of each year. The first contact session will be of 5 days duration and the second one will be of 3 days duration. There will be an intervening period of 6 months after each contact session for online learning and at the end of one year, certificate of completion will be awarded, subject to fulfillment of other requirements. One of them is completion of educational project.

The course fee for the entire course (two contact sessions and two online leanings of 6 months each) is Rs. 12,500/- (Twelve Thousand Five Hundred only). Participants need to make their own arrangements for travel. Accommodation at nominal rates will be available during the contact sessions on first come first serve basis.

**The eligibility criteria for the FIME** are as follows:

- Successful completion of the MCI Basic course Workshop in MET (certificate to be attached)
- At least three years of teaching experience as a faculty (Assistant Professor upwards)
- Recommendation from the Dean/ Principal

*Institution specific eligibility of participants: 30% of faculty who have undergone Basic Course Workshop in MET and should spread across specialties and Cadres.*

**As Per the directives from MCI – This Course will be exclusively conducted for Coordinators and (Co-coordinators) of ME Units and the faculty involved in curriculum planning of the institute. So the Deans of the institution are required to forward the application of Coordinators, Co-coordinators and Faculty involved in curriculum planning only.**

The admission for the FIME will be confirmed only after reception of application by the participant in a prescribed format ( Application form attached) forwarded by the Dean along with cheque/D.D of Rs.12,500/- in favour of **“Seth GS Medical College & KEM Hospital, Diamond Jubilee Society Trust”** payable in Mumbai. Before sending the application, availability of seats for the FIME should be confirmed.
