Please note that following policy decisions were taken in the common meeting of IEC I and IEC II on 13th March, 2014,

- The "Principal investigator (PI) must be a faculty / employee of Seth G. S. Medical College and KEM Hospital and have appropriate post graduate qualification approved by the respective statutory council". Employee of Seth GSMC & KEMH would be a PI, even the Adhoc employee who is faculty can be a Pl.
- For thesis submitted by Resident / post graduate students: Anybody as per the definition of PI can become PI.
- For the studies in collaboration with NIRRH & NIIH: Faculty from Seth GSMC and KEMH would be PI.
- For Thesis / Dissertation of Wadia Maternity and Paediatrics: Faculty from the Wadia hospital are faculty of Seth GSMC & KEMH. Hence faculties from Wadia hospital can be PI for the thesis submitted by the postgraduate students of Wadia hospital, however the recruitment of participant should be from only Wadia Hospital and not from the Seth GSMC & KEMH.
- For the dissertations submitted by nursing students: Nursing faculty from the Seth GSMC can be PI however nursing students from the colleges other than GSMC should add faculty from Seth GSMC as PI.
- For the dissertations submitted by Ph.D, Msc (KEM Hospital) and Msc. Pharma Medicine (MUHS) Faculty from Seth GSMC and KEMH would be PI and the thesis and the dissertation should be approved by the respective department's DRB.
