With reference to the above letter, the following have been pointed out by you.

Sr no-2- Examination halls: NIL against requirement of 3 of capacity of 250 each- NOT RECTIFIED

Reply from Seth GS Medical College

(i) Two halls located in the Wadia group of hospitals, which constitute a part of Seth GS Medical College & KEM Hospital complex are used for examination purpose.

(ii) Three halls on the first floor of the Orthopaedic Centre and one in the Nursing College are also used.

All these halls are flat as per MCI norms and can accommodate the examinee as per the examination schedule of Maharashtra University of Health Sciences (morning and evening batches of total 750 students). A representative photograph of these is enclosed for your ready reference.

(iii) As reiterated, we have received an administrative approval for constructing a new building in the KEM campus, wherein 3 examination halls of requisite capacity will be located at one place. MCI will be intimated as soon as the work is completed.

Sr no 3 –Lecture theaters – hospital lecture theater is not available. Capacity of 4 lecture theaters available is only 180 against 240 each required.- PARTIALLY RECTIFIED

Reply from Seth GS Medical College

(i) We would like to inform that the current lecture halls in the college building (n=4) are spacious being an old time heritage construction. Hence we have enhanced the capacity of these lecture theatres by adding extra writing chairs in front row, back row and on the side (total rows 14 each with a 17 sitting places = 238 + 2 extra on side = 240). Photographs showing the seating capacity of the 4 theatres of 240 each is enclosed.

(ii) We have one additional lecture theatre on the ground floor of the college building which has capacity to accommodate 300 students.

We hope this fulfils the requirement of MCI for lecture theatre.

(iii) There are 2 lecture theaters [capacity 140 and 75] in the hospital that are routinely used to teach students.

(iv) We would also like to point out that the college building and the hospital building are connected with each other by a small passage and students undergoing training in the hospital can reach any of the lecture halls in the college building within 5 minutes.
