Both committees presently functions according to the requirements laid down in Schedule Y and is guided by the ICH GCP guidelines for Good Clinical Practice, ethical principles set forth in the Declaration of Helsinki and the Ethical Guidelines for Biomedical Research on Human Subjects laid down by the Indian Council of Medical Research.

### Activities of the IEC-I

A total of **55 meetings (11 full board meetings and 44 SAE Subcommittee meetings)** were held in the year 2017.A total of 19 pharmaceutical sponsored projects, 1 government sponsored project, 78 other academic projects and 102 thesis / dissertations were submitted to the IEC-I for initial review during the year.

4 other academic & 2 thesis projects were approved at first submission as there were scientific and ethical lacunae in the submitted protocols. The comments by the IEC-I members, pertaining to modifications in the protocol were sent to investigators. The answers to IEC-I comments were then reviewed and the project was granted approval.
