Sir,

I am directed to inform you that the Board of Governors noted the Council letter dated 27.01.2010 conveying therein the decision of the Executive Committee to issue a show cause notice to the authorities of Seth G.S. Medical College, Mumbai as to why the recognition for the award of MBBS degree should not be withdrawn u/s 19 of the IMC Act, 1956, alongwith compliance submitted in reference to show cause notice and decided to verify the same. Accordingly, the compliance verification assessment of your college was carried out on 14th & 15th Sept, 2010.

The compliance verification assessment report (14th & 15th Sept., 2010) submitted by the Council Assessors was considered by the Board of Governors. The Board of Governors decided to revoke the earlier decision taken by the Executive Committee at its meeting held on 12.01.2010 to issue a show cause notice and further decided that the recognition of MBBS degree granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nasik in respect of students being trained at Seth G.S. Medical College, Mumbai be continued restricting the number of admissions to 180 (One Hundred and Eighty) students per year.

It is further to inform you that your institution are fully responsible to fulfill and maintain norms including the infrastructure both physical and human resource, teaching faculty and clinical material etc. throughout, as stipulated in Regulation of Medical Council of India. In case false/wrong declaration or fabricated documents have been used for procuring the approval of Continuation of recognition of the Board of Governors and the said misconduct is brought to notice or comes to the knowledge of MCI at any stage, your institution is not liable to be considered for approval of continuation of recognition with the annual intake capacity of 180 students and this approval is also liable to be revoked. Besides, MCI is entitled to take all such measures against you and your college/institution as permissible under the law.

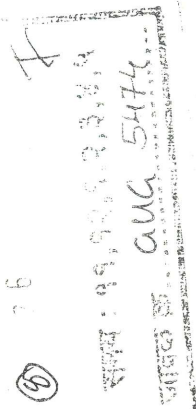

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to inform that the compliance verification assessment of the physical and the other teaching facilities available for continuance of recognition of MBBS degree granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik in respect of students being trained at Seth G.S. Medical College, Mumbai was carried out by the Council assessors on 06th February, 2018. The said assessment report along with previous assessment reports (26th July, 2017, 8th March, 2017 and 22nd & 23rd Feb., 2016) was considered by the Executive Committee at its meeting held on 05.03.2018 and it was decided as under:-

"The Executive Committee of the Council considered the compliance verification assessment report (06th February, 2018) along with previous assessment reports (26th July, 2017, 8th March, 2017 and 22nd & 23rd Feb., 2016) and decided to recommend that recognition of MBBS degree granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik in respect of students being trained at Seth G.S. Medical College, Mumbai be continued restricting the number of admissions to 180 (One Hundred Eighty) students."

The Executive Committee further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Sections 8(3)(2), 8(3)(3) & 8(3)(4) of the Establishment of Medical Colleges Regulations (Amendment), 2010 (Part II) dated 16th April, 2010 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

- 8 (3) ...
- (2) *The recognition so granted to an Undergraduate Course for award of degree shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.*
- (3) *The procedure for 'Renewal' of recognition shall be same as applicable for the award of recognition.*
- (4) *Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub clause (a) supra shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Undergraduate Course of MBBS at the said institute."*
