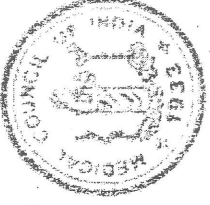

Sub: Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik - Recognition of MD(Anaesthesiology) qualification against increased intake from 16 to 22 seats in respect of students being trained at Seth GS Medical College & King Edward VII Memorial Hospital, Parel Mumbai, Maharashtra.

Sir/ Madam,

I am to state that the General Body of this council at its meeting held on 26-27/03/2015 considered the Council assessor report (June, 2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Seth GS Medical College & King Edward VII Memorial Hospital, Parel Mumbai, Maharashtra for purpose of Recognition of MD(Anaesthesiology) qualification against increased intake from 16 to 22 seats granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

The Council approved the following recommendations of the Postgraduate Committee, which I am directed to convey herewith for your information and necessary action:-

"The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Assessment Report (June, 2014) and decided to recommend that MD(Anaesthesiology) qualification against increased intake from 16 to 22 seats granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik in respect of students being trained at Seth GS Medical College & King Edward VII Memorial Hospital, Parel Mumbai, Maharashtra be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course."

I am to state that the Council Inspector's report (May, 1978) on the standard of examination and the facilities for training available at (i) Grant Medical College, Bombay, (ii) Seth G.S.
