- 1. Four passport size color photographs.
- 2. Candidate has to submit the **Folder** with original and attested certificates to the clerk in charge of admission for verification at the time of reporting the College.
- 3. After documents verification, candidate will have to pay the fees in the Cash Section of the College office.
- 4. After payment of fees candidate will have to take blank undertaking form, agreement form, and get it franked with Rs.100/- adhesive stamp
- 5. Candidate will have to fill the application form completely and submit to the clerk in charge along with agreement and undertaking.
- 6. All D. M. / M. Ch. candidates will be under Bond to serve the Govt. of Maharashtra for <u>2</u> years after passing their D. M. / M. Ch. Degree examination or will have to pay penalty of <u>Rs. 2 Crores</u> along with interest if applicable for the default. (As per DMER rules)
- 7. Any candidate responsible for lapse of D. M. / M. Ch. Post graduation medical seat will have to pay Additional penalty of Rs. 10, 00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs Only) and 2 Academic years course fees.
- 8. Students seeking admission for D. M. / M. Ch. post graduate courses should complete Senior residency tenure, failing which he/she will be required to pay Rs. 10,00,000/- (i.e. for non completion of Senior Residency tenure). However, this is not applicable to the candidate of NEET SS 2022, resigning the PG registration before the prescribed date which will be notified in due course.
- 9. At the time of commencement of residency for A. Y. 2022 D. M. / M. Ch. as the case may be P.G. students are required to submit P.G. Registration and Enrollment form of MUHS, Nashik University duly signed by the P.G. Teacher and H.O.D. of the concerned Department to post graduate section, college office within seven days of joining of residency.
